

Confederate Names Inventory Report

Anne Stuntz, Barbara Naef Fairfax County History Commission December 8, 2020

June 23 Board Matter: History Commission to create inventory of Confederate street names, Confederate monuments, and Confederate named public places in Fairfax County. A July 7 follow up meeting further refined the scope.

Methodology: 26,552 Fairfax County street and place names identified, 650 well-known Confederate officers and locally well-known Confederates listed, matches filtered, places researched.

Guidelines: Local, state, and national organizations provided guidance for productive, inclusive community discussions through which communities can decide the best course of action for the future of public monuments, street names, and other historical references.

Recommendations: BOS to establish a robust public process for considering future actions. Confederate Inventory Report and supplemental research be archived with the Virginia Room of the Fairfax County Regional Library.

History Commission 2021 Initiative: Develop inventory of research materials on African American communities in Fairfax County.

Alexandria and City of Fairfax Public Processes: Models for addressing Confederate associated assets.
