COMMONWEALTH'S ATTORNEY STEVE DESCANO ANNOUNCES JAEYOUNG LEE FOUND GUILTY FOR 2017 SHOOTING

Fairfax County, VA — Commonwealth's Attorney Steve Descano announced today that a jury convicted Jaeyoung Lee, 34, of seven felonies in sprawling case related to the 2017 shooting of Jeremy Tammone, 49. The jury found Lee guilty of aggravated malicious wounding, as well as felony firearm use, wiretapping, possession of burglarous tools, malicious computer use, and two counts of using a computer to gather personal information.

On the night of October 21, 2017, Lee shot into Tammone's apartment and grievously injured him. Tammone was a friend of Lee's ex-girlfriend, Jeny Mills, 34, and prosecutors showed during trial that Lee had been surveilling Mills' actions for months, including hacking her social media accounts to monitor her messages, installing cameras in her home, and making copies of her apartment door locks to practice unlocking them.

"This is a serious case that left the victim permanently impaired, and today's verdict represents a just outcome for the community," said CA Descano. "I am grateful to the detectives, whose investigative work was essential to this result."

Lee will be sentenced on October 26 for the seven felonies and faces up to life in prison for the malicious wounding charge.
