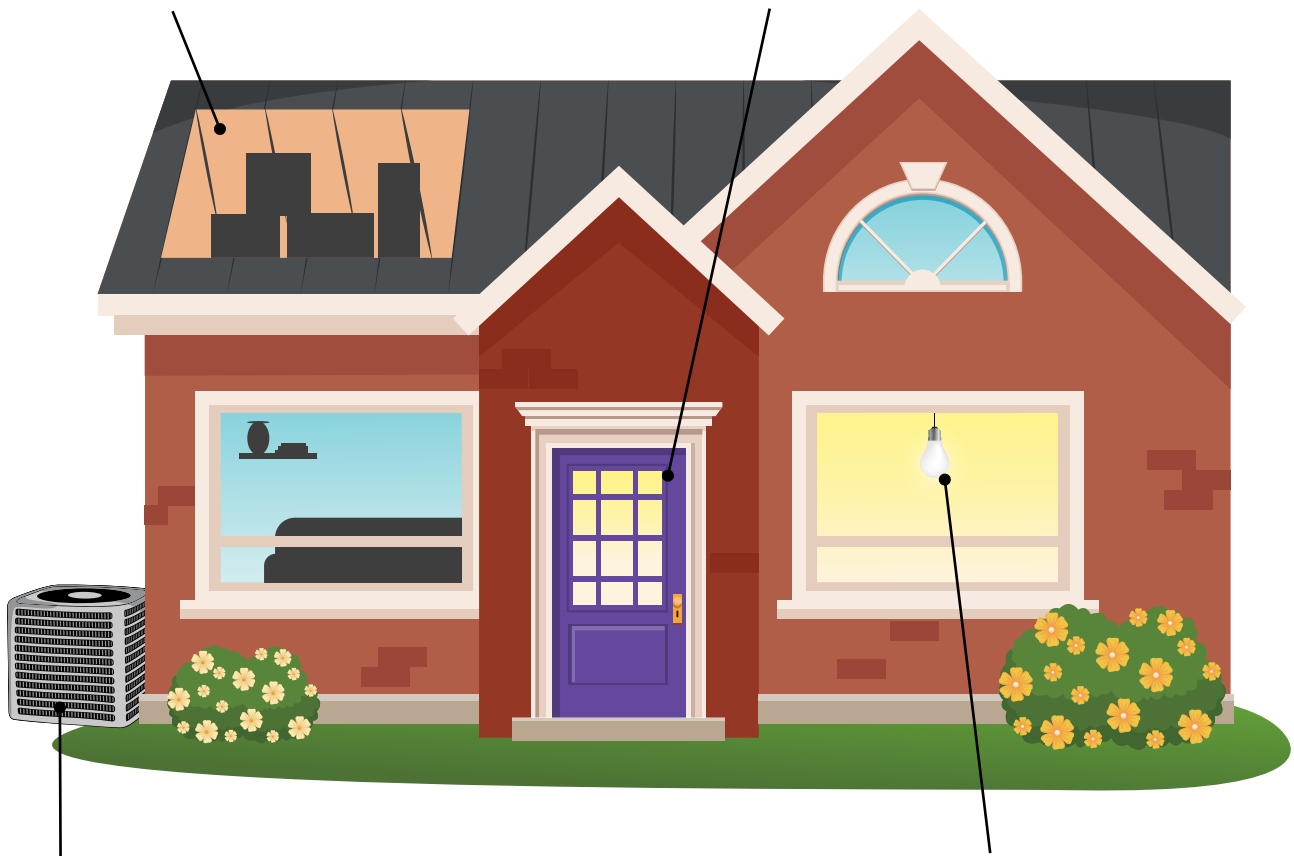
## A home energy auditor might check...
