GENERAL NOTES:

LANDSCAPE CONTRACTOR SHALL VERIFY ALL QUANTITIES AND SHALL NOTIFY LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT OF ANY DISCREPANCIES.

2. THE LANDSCAPE CONTRACTOR SHALL VERIFY THE EXISTENCE OF AND STAKE ALL UTILITIES PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION. EXCAVATION OF PLANT PITS LOCATED WITHIN 5'
OF UTILITIES SHALL BE PERFORMED BY HAND. ANY UTILITY/PLANT MATERIAL CONFLICTS
SHALL BE BROUGHT TO THE ATTENTION OF THE LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT PRIOR TO

3. THE LANDSCAPE CONTRACTOR SHALL SUPPLY ALL PLANT MATERIALS IN QUANTITIES SUFFICIENT TO COMPLETE THE PLANTINGS SHOWN ON ALL DRAWINGS, ALL PLANTS SHALL MEET SPECIES AND SIZE SPECIFIED ON THE APPROVED PLANS. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL GUARANTEE PLANT HEALTH AND SURVIVABILITY FOR ONE YEAR FROM DATE OF PROJECT ACCEPTANCE, ANY MATERIAL NOT MEETING SPECIFICATIONS OR DISPLAYING POOR HEALTH SHALL BE REPLACED AT CONTRACTOR'S EXPENSE.

4. ALL PLANT MATERIAL SHALL MEET THE STANDARD SPECIFIED IN <u>AMERICAN STANDARD</u> <u>FOR NURSERY STOCK</u> (ANSI 280.1). NOTIFY LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT A MINIMUM OF ONE WEEK PRIOR TO PLANT DELIVERY TO SCHEDULE ON-SITE INSPECTION UPON DELIVERY, INSTALLED PLANT MATERIAL NOT MEETING SPECIFICATIONS SHALL BE REMOVED AND REPLACED AT CONTRACTOR'S EXPENSE.

5. THE LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT RESERVES THE RIGHT TO MAKE PLANTING BED FIELD CHANGES TO ACCOMMODATE SITE CONDITIONS AND TO ACHIEVE THE DESIGN INTENT. THE LANDSCAPE CONTRACTOR SHALL FLAG ALL TREE AND BEDLINE LOCATIONS FOR APPROVAL BY LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT PRIOR TO ANY INSTALLATION.

8. ALL PLANTS SHALL BE PLANTED AS SPECIFIED IN VIRGINIA COOPERATIVE EXTENSION PUBLICATION 430-295, TREE AND SHRUB PLANTING GUIDELINES.*

7. PFM 12-0705 SHALL BE FOLLOWED FOR TREE AND SHRUB GUIDELINES, TO INCLUDE STORAGE, MULCHING, WATERING, ETC.

8. TREES SHALL NOT BE INSTALLED WITHIN 4 FEET OF ANY BARRIER.

9, DO NOT CREATE MOUNDS FOR TREES IN PARKING ISLANDS. INSTALL ALL PLANTS WITH


10. THE LANDSCAPE CONTRACTOR SHALL CONDUCT REPRESENTATIVE SOIL ANALYSIS PRIOR TO THE INSTALLATION OF ANY PLANT MATERIAL. THE LANDSCAPE CONTRACTOR SHALL NOTIFY THE LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT OF ANY IMPROPER SOIL CONDITION (NUTRITIONAL DEFICIENCIES, WETNESS, MUCK, DEBRIS, ETC.) AND SHALL RECOMMEND FOR APPROVAL, PRIOR TO INSTALLATION, ALL SOIL AMENDMENTS THAT MAY BE NECESSARY TO PROMOTE HEALTHY, VIGOROUS PLANT GROWTH.

11. THE LANDSCAPE CONTRACTOR SHALL REPAIR OR REPLACE ANY EXISTING VEGETATION DISTURBED BY PLANT MATERIAL INSTALLATION ACTIVITIES. THIS REPAIRIREPLACEMENT SHALL BLEND SEAMLESSLY WITH THE EXISTING LANDSCAPE. LANDSCAPE CONT

12. THE LANDSCAPE CONTRACTOR SHALL COORDINATE WITH THE GENERAL CONTRACTOR IN PREPARING PLANTING AREA FINAL GRADE ELEVATIONS.

13. LANDSCAPE CONTRACTOR SHALL NOTIFY LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT A MINIMUM OF 48 HOURS PRIOR TO COMPLETION TO SCHEDULE FINAL WALK THROUGH. A FINAL WALK THROUGH SHALL NOT BE PERFORMED IF PREVIOUS PUNCH LIST ITEMS ARE NOT COMPLETED.

14. BIORETENTION FACILITIES SHALL BE POSTED WITH PERMANENT SIGNS DESIGNATING THE AREA AS A WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT AREA PER PFM 6-1307.3C, PLATE 81-6.





Plant any trees, shrubs, or potted plants prior to application of specified compost blanket. Apply 3-inch blanket of specified compost prior to or during seed application. Compost shall be 3-oilmete Compost a mailable from Loudoun Composting 44150 Wade Drive, Chentilly, VA 20152, Prione, 193-327-4425, PAX: 703-327-0459 or an approved equal. The paper work (shipping invoices), samples and STA certifications for all compost used shall be submitted and approved prior to installation, Attendate must be STA approved by the U.S. Composting Council's Seal of Yesting Assurance Program.

Broadcast, pump or hand seed at 148/1500 ft² and annual rye (Lotum muttiforum) at 18/1500 ft² on top of applied 3-inch blanket of specified compost. Seed may be mixed with specified compost to assist in hand seeding. Substitute winter wheat for annual rye if seeding after October 1. Reseed and much all areas with less than 50% germination.


