## LAND USE ACTIONS

During the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter of Fiscal Year 2021 the Planning Commission acted on **35** applications; affording 29 citizens an opportunity to speak at the 7 public hearings held. The district with the highest number of applications considered was the Sully District with 7 applications acted upon.



## **COMMITTEE ACTIVITY**

#### Land Use Process Review (LUPR) Committee

Met on July 23<sup>rd</sup> electronically due to the State of Emergency caused by the COVID-19 pandemic. The Zoning Administration staff offered a presentation on the Proposed 2020 Zoning Ordinance Amendment Work Program (ZOAWP). In addition, Clarion Associates, LLC, addressed the committee with a presentation on the Consolidated Draft for the Zoning Ordinance Modernization Project (zMOD).

### **Capital Improvement Program (CIP) Committee**

On September 24<sup>th</sup>, the CIP Committee held a joint meeting with the Fairfax County School Board. Staff from the Department of Management and Budget gave a presentation on the background and recommendations for the joint meeting. The Committee, School Board, and staff discussed opportunities for future collaboration and ideas for the One Fairfax initiative. Topics included colocation, joint space usage between County agencies and schools, schedules for school renovations, available space for repurposing, and workforce housing on school sites. The Committee voted to name Timothy Sargeant, as the Committee Chair, to serve as a liaison between the joint Committee with the School Board and Board of Supervisors and the Planning Commission CIP Committee.
