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- Objective 2: Make <u>Encourage</u> land-use and public facilit<u>yies</u> investment<u>s</u> decisions- that promote high quality education <u>opportunities</u> for <u>all community members</u>, <u>including</u> pre-school through 12th grades<u>-students</u>, <u>and higher and adult</u> <u>education</u>, to <u>include but not limited to</u>, apprenticeships, career and technical training, and certification programs, <u>higher education</u>, and adult <u>education</u>:
  - Policy a. Promote the development and redevelopment of a variety of equitable housing typesland use and revitalization that encourages socioeconomic diversity throughout the county that meet the FCPS goal to balance socioeconomic diversity in its schools.and minimizes pockets of poverty.
  - Policy b. Foster Encourage diverse and high quality educational options programs that help develop the skills community members needed to adapt to economic changes and challenges in the economy workplace due to continuing and technological and workplace innovations.
  - Policy c. <u>Collaborate Join with the public, private</u>, <u>businesses, and non-profit</u> <u>organizationssectors</u>, and other partners to provide <u>education and training</u> <u>programs and opportunities for all</u> county residents access to opportunities for <u>knowledge and</u><u>develop the necessary</u> skills <u>to enter</u>, <u>succeed</u>, and <u>advance</u> <u>development needed to be successful</u> in the workplace and <u>in the</u> community.
  - Policy d. <u>Enable access toPromote</u> high-quality, life-long educational and training programs and opportunities for adults to expand their knowledge and skills in competitive, challenging, and changing environments.
