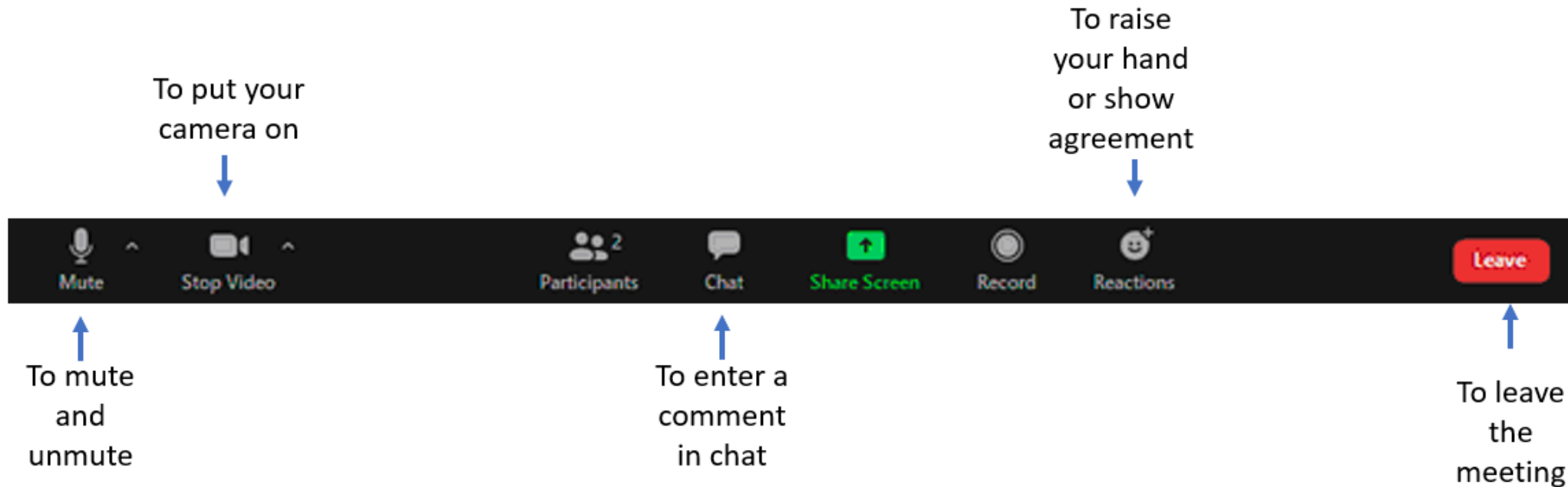

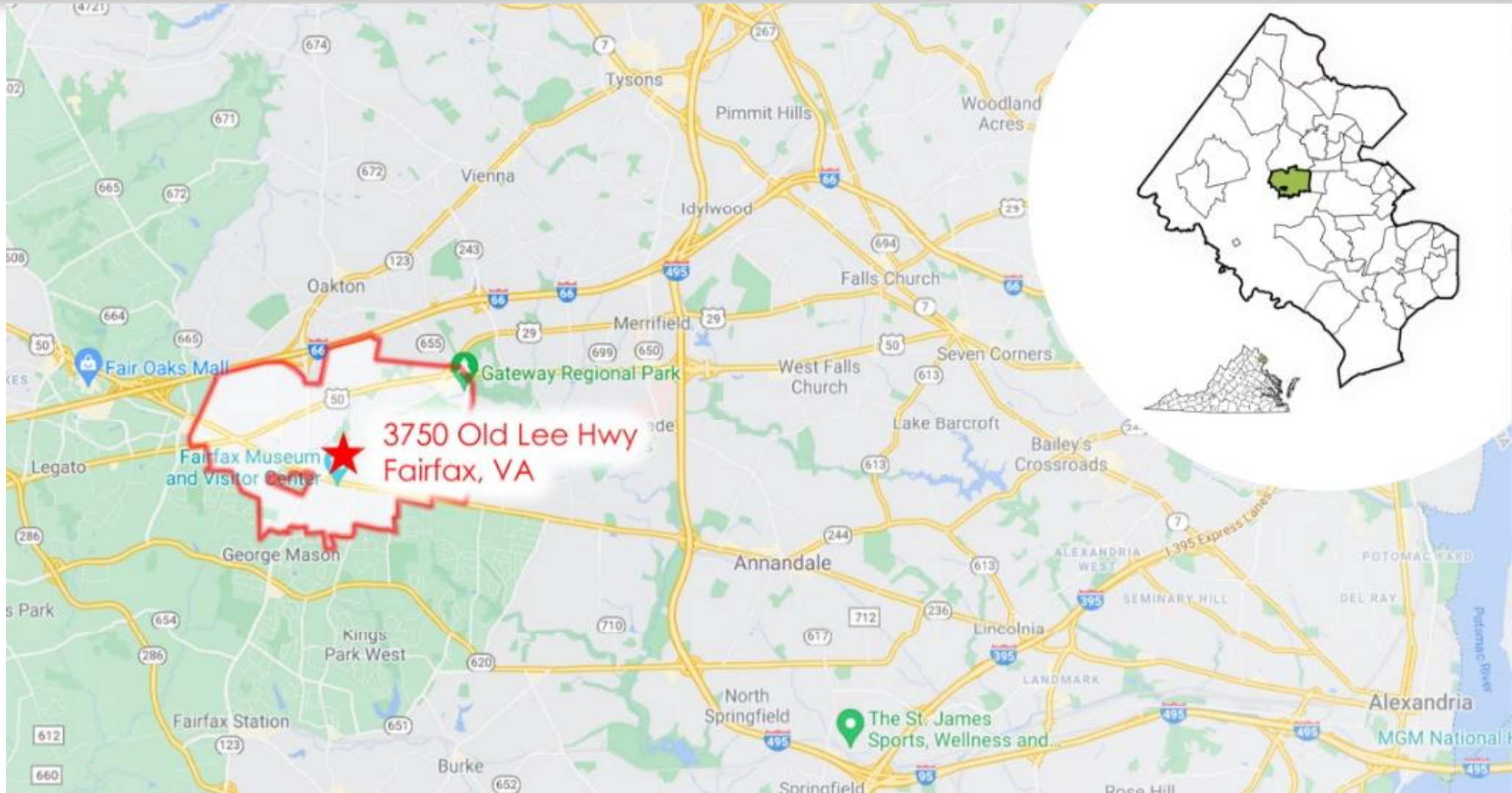

Project Background

Feasibility studies

- **Green Acres Community Center:**
2015 – 2016
Identified needs to relocate some programs.
- **Joseph Willard Health Center:**
2017 - 2018
Identified need for a replacement of the facility.
- **Master Plan study:**
2018-2019
Campus-type redevelopment on Willard and Sherwood sites.

City and County joint redevelopment potential

- Partnership
- Integration of current services
- Benefits both City and County residents
- Accommodate needs identified by the feasibility studies
- Improve ingress/egress, site circulation and parking
- Bring health, wellness, fitness, childcare and the arts together on one campus



Existing Facilities

Green Acres Community Center

4401 Sideburn Road, Fairfax, VA, 22030

- Owned and operated by City of Fairfax
- Built in 1961 as a school building
- 40,000 Sq. Ft. building | 10-acre site
- Features City's senior center, exercise facilities, multipurpose rooms for classes and rentals
- Needs significant renovations for accessibility, operation and amenities desired by residents
- Some programs from this center are identified to relocate to the new facility



Existing Facilities

Stacy C. Sherwood Community Center

3740 Old Lee Highway, Fairfax, VA 22030

- Owned and operated by City of Fairfax
- Venue for recreational classes, preschool, after school care, multi purpose classrooms performance & banquet spaces
- Adjacent to Van Dyck Park
- 30,000 individuals served each year
- Identified for relocation of some programs from Green Acres Center



Existing Facilities

Joseph Willard Health Center

3750 Old Lee Highway, Fairfax VA, 22030

- Owned and operated by Fairfax County.
- Built in 1954, addition in 1966, major renovation in 1975, minor renovation in 2010.
- 30,000 Sq. Ft., two levels.
- Houses programs and services supporting health and wellbeing of infants, children, women and families.
- Programs include licensed medical, nurse's clinic, dental, pharmacy, speech and hearing, X-ray services, vital records, Women Infants Children, Infant Toddler Connection, and admin.
- Designated as FCHD Continuity of Operations (COOP).

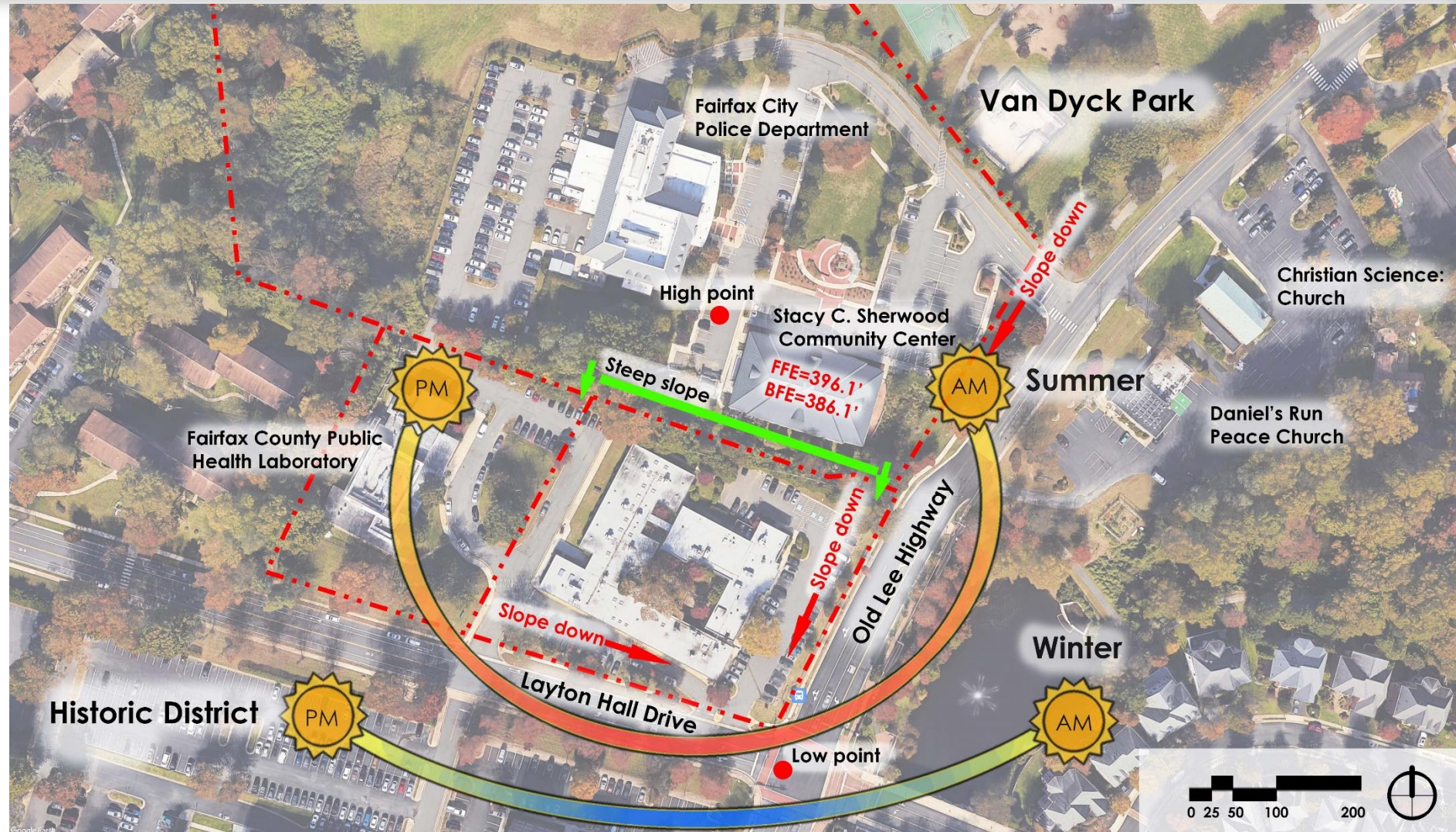
Topography

- High point by Sherwood Community Center.
- Low point at intersection of Old Lee Highway & Layton Hall Drive.
- 20 feet of elevation change between those 2 points.
- Steepest slopes are between the Willard and Sherwood sites.

Visibility



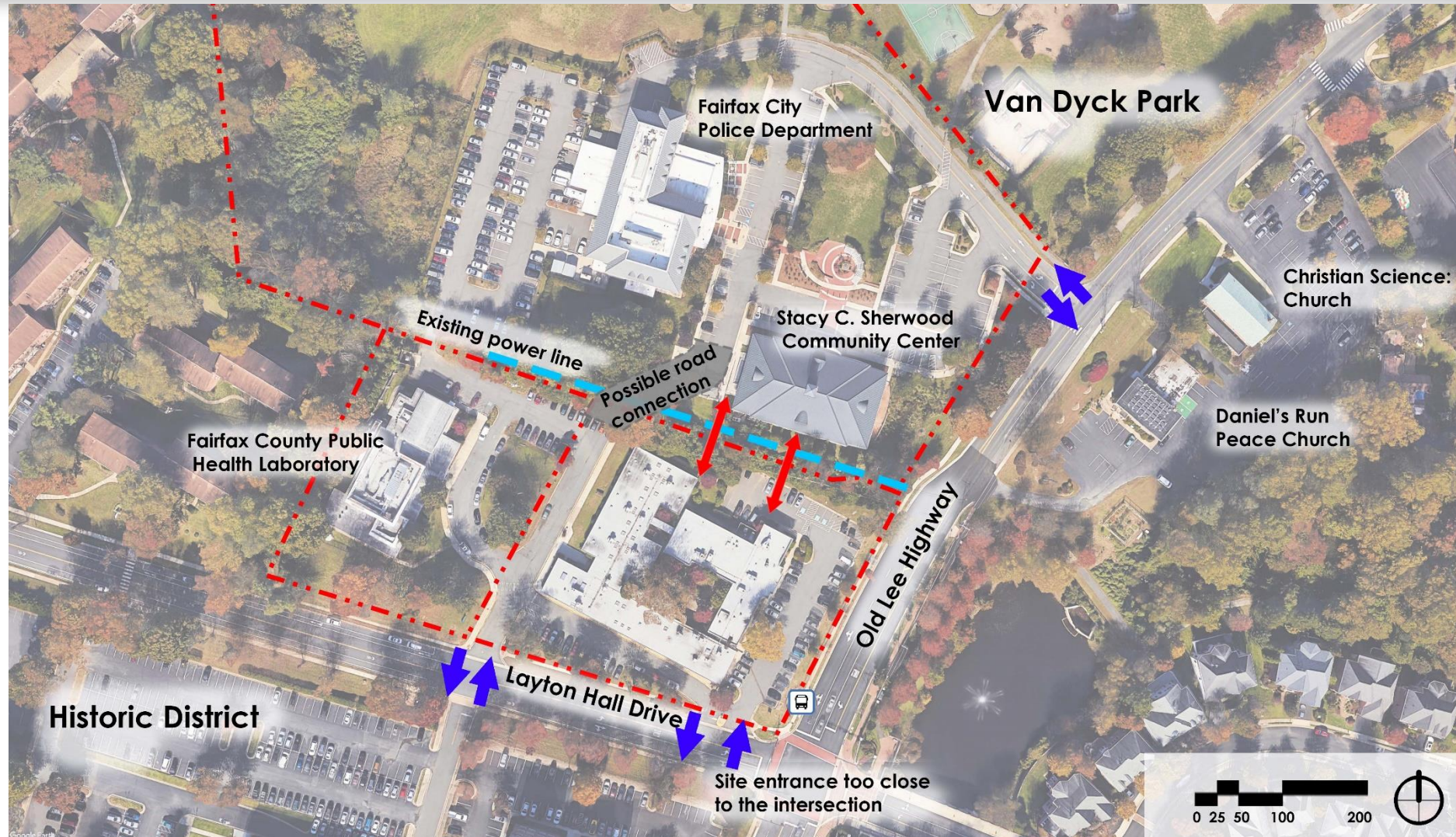
Project Site

Site Constraints

- Tight Site
- Limited access points
- Utilities between Willard & Sherwood sites.

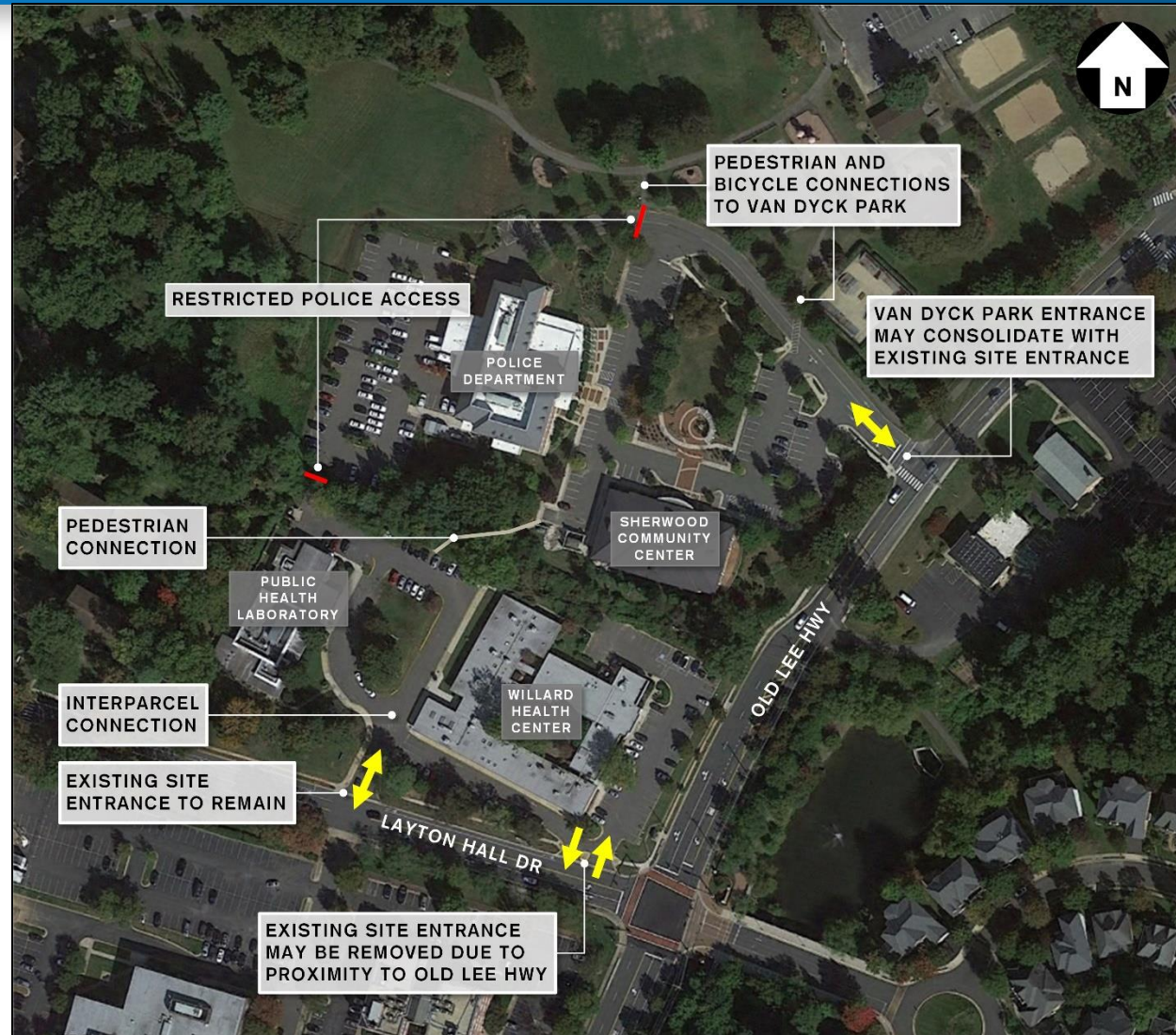
Site Opportunities

- Potential to connect Willard & Sherwood Sites internally for better flow and circulation.
- Eliminate dangerous entrance at intersection.
- Consolidated facility to accommodate more parking and site amenities.
- Synergies between uses



Site Access and Circulation

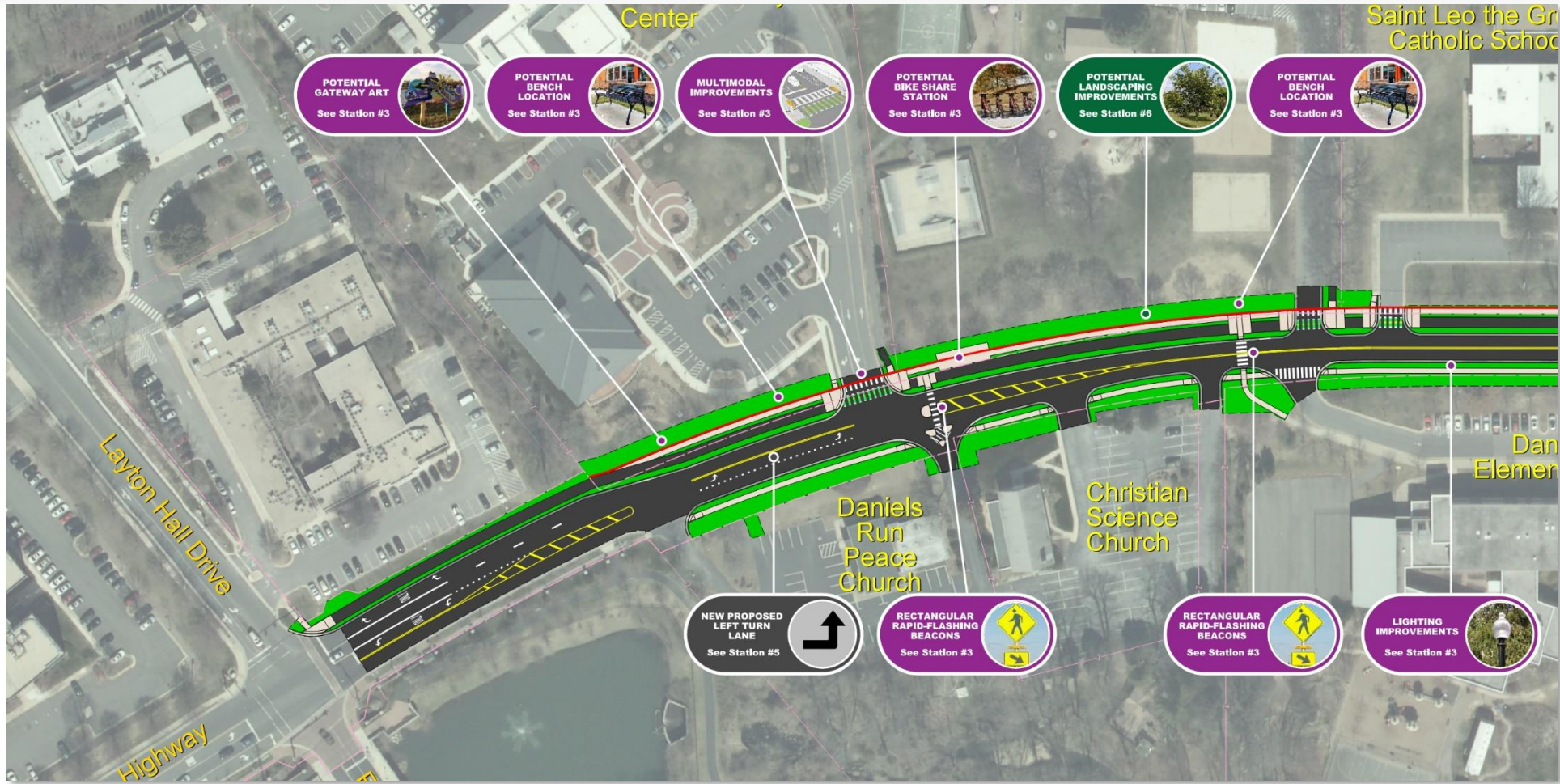
- Existing site access provided via Old Lee Highway and Layton Hall Drive
- No current vehicular connection between northern and southern portions of the site
- Pedestrian and bicycle connections to Van Dyck Park
- Sidewalks in place along Old Lee Highway and Layton Hall Drive



Traffic Impact Analysis (TIA) Process

- **Scope**
 - Scoped with City on January 26, 2022
 - Determine study area and parameters of the TIA ← **WE ARE HERE**
- **Prepare**
 - Evaluate existing and future conditions for vehicles, pedestrians, bicycles, and public transit
 - Assess impact of proposed development on surrounding road, pedestrian, and bicycle networks
 - Identify impacts and present recommended mitigations (if necessary)
- **Submit**
 - Submit TIA to City staff for review and comment
 - Address comments and resubmit (if necessary)
- **Approval**

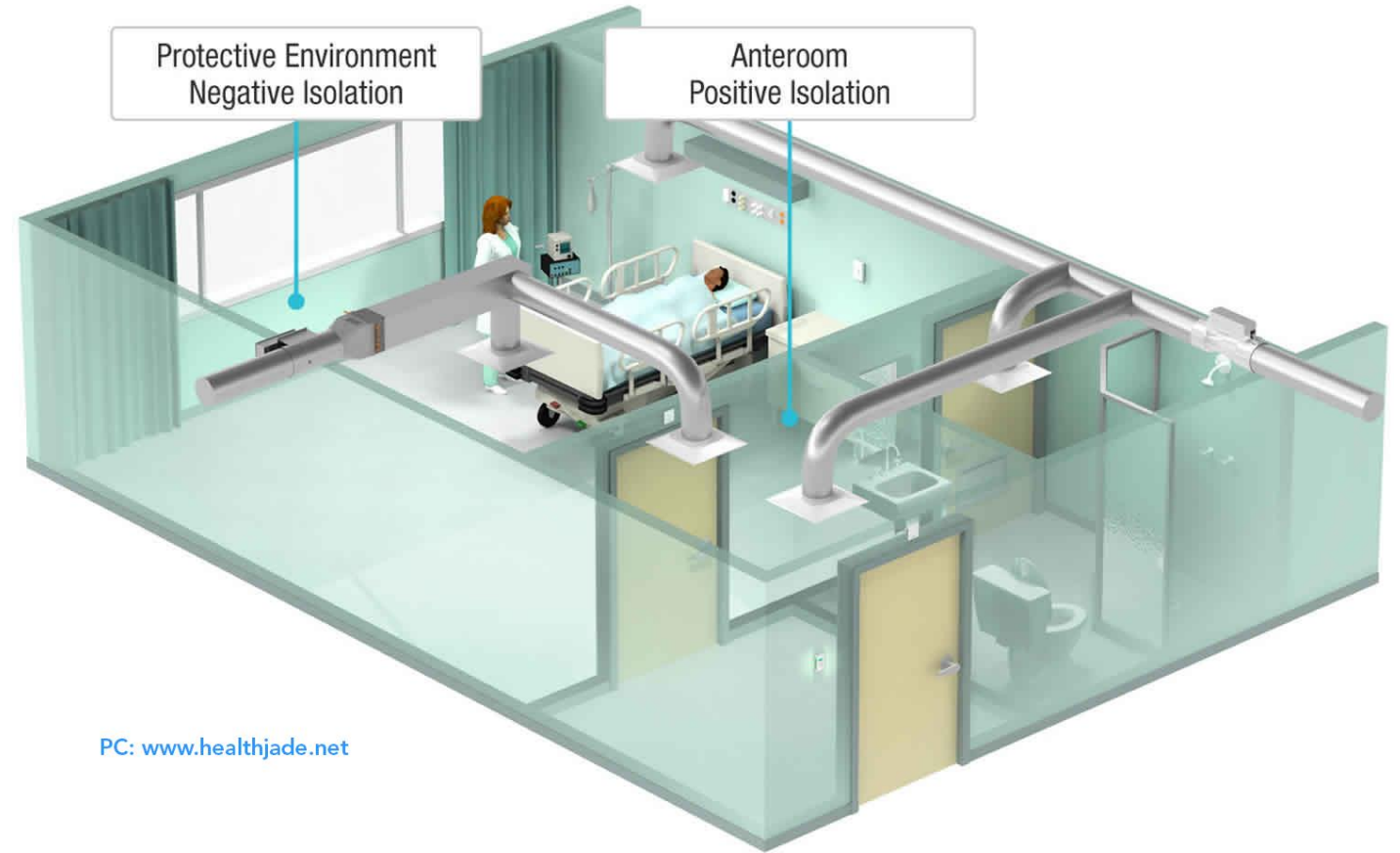

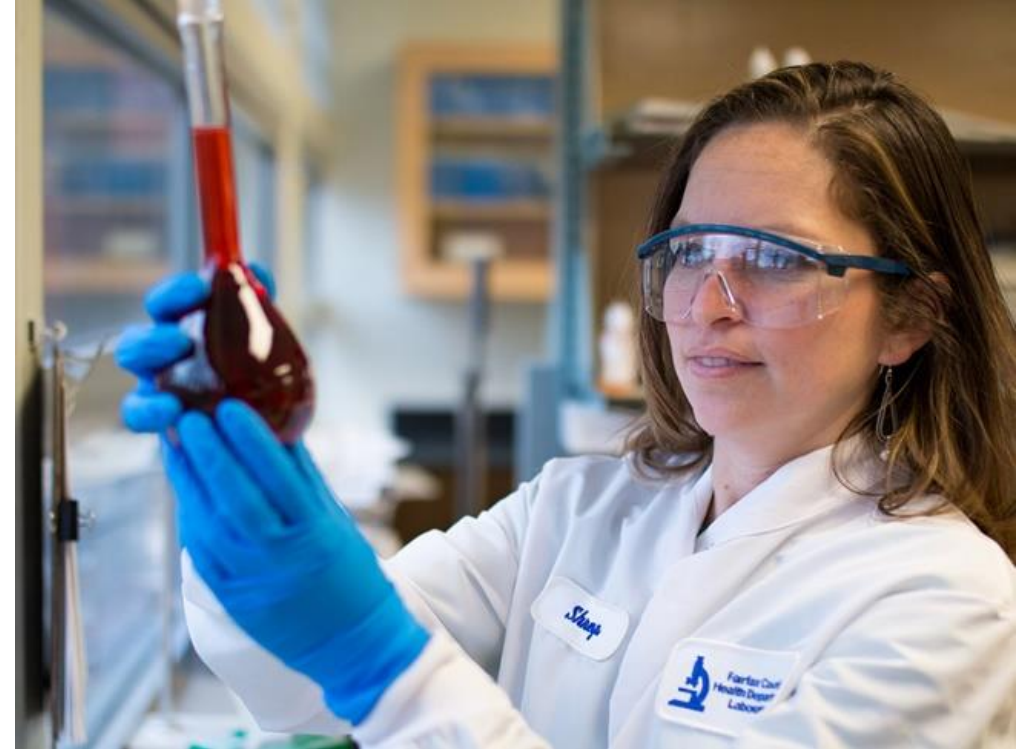
